FORMAT FOR ALL NAMDER PLATES USED IN BMX RACING

The BMX Race plates identify the types of riders or classes that they race in. The following examples detail all the versions that are sanctioned by BMXNZ.

There are some simple regulations around the plates so that they are clear and easy to be read by officials.

- Numbers are to be 75mm tall and approx. 10mm wide (depending on the font used)
- The club suffix must be 25mm tall
- The numbers used can be any number from 51 to 999. The numbers below this can only be used for one year, by riders who have achieved their corresponding ranking position from the immediately preceding National Championship.

All numbers & suffixes must be readable by officials.

Please note all ranking plates can only be used at event that are the same or lower than the one where it was gained. For example, you cannot use your Island Title ranked plate at the Nationals.

The base colours used are core CMYK colours

- RED C-0, M-100, Y-100, K-0
- YELLOW C-0, M-10, Y-95, K-0
- BLUE C-100, M-90, Y-0, K-0
- GREY C-50, M-41, Y-41, K-5

The base colour MUST make up 80% of the plate surface.

Striders – Blue Number on a White Plate
Sprockets – Red Numbers on a White Plate
Female 20" – White Numbers on a Blue Plate
Male 20" – Black Numbers on a Yellow Plate
Cruisers – White Numbers on a Red Plate
Championship Jnr – White Numbers on a Black Plate
Championship U23 – White Numbers on a Gray Plate
Championship Elite – Black Number on a White Plate
